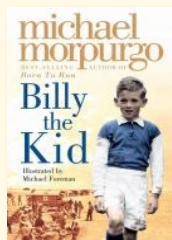


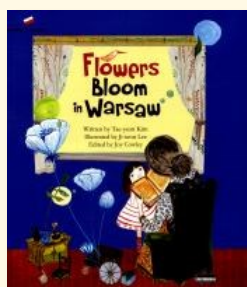


In November, We Remember. War can also affect the lives of children; beautifully explained in these chosen titles; available in the Library.

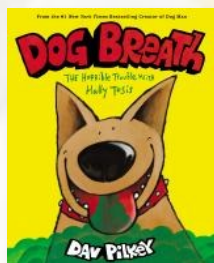

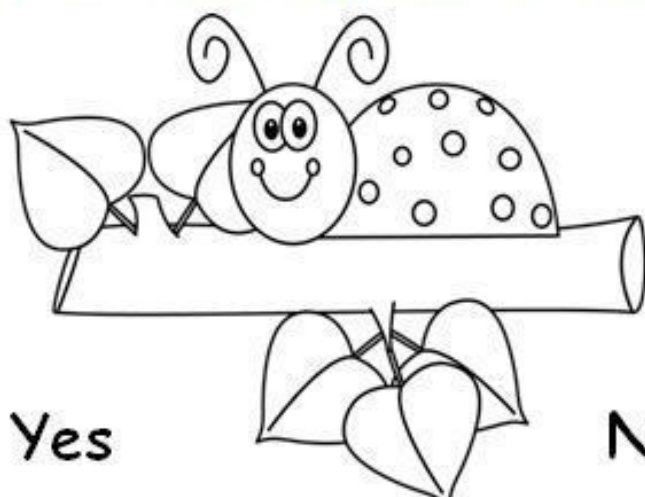

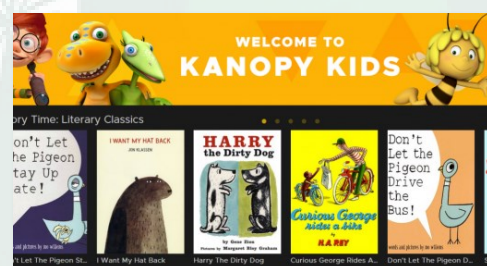
