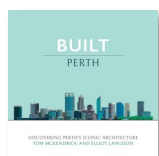

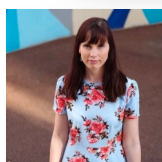
Literary Salons in the Library welcomes Emily Paull in conversation with Gabriella Filippi.

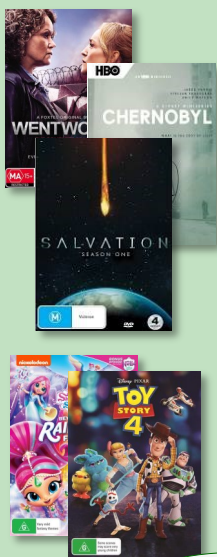

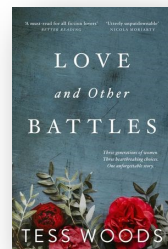

Three generations of women, three heartbreaking choices, one unforgettable story.

Wow. This is my first taste of this author, and I'm disappointed that I missed her first two books (need to rectify that quickly!). A very engaging storyline that switched between the three main ladies in their respective timelines as well as the present for all three. All three were very likeable and in a word, brave; brave in their life battles and choices. The narrative is quite heartbreaking at times but also uplifting at other times. There is a final reveal at the end of the book that just pushed my emotions over the edge and had me both crying and thinking wait how did I even miss this; it was extremely well done. Can't praise this book highly enough and I very strongly recommend it!

War service summary information is also available for soldiers associated with the district who served in WWII.

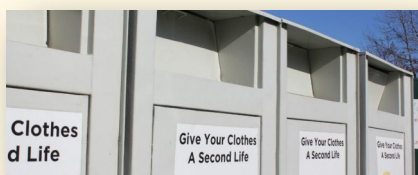


Lest We Forget

Many charities sell second-hand goods and clothing via shops. They're great places to pick up a bargain and help a great cause at the same time!

However, please donate wisely. Charities are paying \$13 million a year to send unusable donations to landfill which represents 60,000 tonnes of waste.
