
The Choice by Claire Wade. (2019)

Imagine a world where everything you ate was monitored by the government. Every step you took was counted. Your children were weighed every day at school. Neighbours report on neighbours and no one was safe from judgement. Sugar was illegal and baking was a crime. Imagine if that world was here now...what would you do? Toe the line...or fight for your freedom...?

As with all the best science fiction it is super believable and easy to imagine, thus all the more horrifying (no sugar at all, eep!). Aside from the horror of no sugar (haha), the book paints a pretty serious picture of one person in charge probably genuinely trying to improve society's health but doing this the completely wrong way.

This is such a fantastic debut for the author, I really look forward to any future offerings.

Anzac Day is an important commemoration where we demonstrate our respect and admiration for Anzacs past and present.

Originally known as the West Guildford Soldiers' Memorial, and located on the corner of Wilson Street and Perth Road, the memorial was officially dedicated on 10th December 1920 by Sir Francis Newdegate, KCMG, State Governor. Built by Wales and Gillies, two returned soldiers who attended the unveiling, the memorial was "Erected by the Citizens of West Guildford to Commemorate the Great War of 1914-1919 in Honour of Those who Fought and Fell in Defence of the Empire."

- Fatigue

If you think you might have the coronavirus or flu – and you probably

won't know for sure – do not attend a medical centre without calling ahead and speaking to a nurse first, as you may risk spreading it further. If you have breathing difficulties, call an ambulance.

In severe cases, symptoms become more advanced:

- Severe acute respiratory syndrome
- Kidney failure pneumonia
- Death

Other coronaviruses spread from an infected person to others through:




the air by coughing and sneezing
